## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing February 2023 as Career and Technical Education Month and February 23,  
2 2023, as Georgia Career and Technical Student Organizations Day at the state capitol; and  
3 for other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, organizations such as CTI, DECA, FBLA, FCCLA, FFA, FRC, HOSA,  
5 SkillsUSA, and TSA, along with career, technical, and agricultural education, provide a solid  
6 foundation for the youth of America and for the future business and economic development  
7 in our state; and

8 WHEREAS, career and technical student organizations promote occupational excellence,  
9 leadership, and citizenship among their members, who are preparing for the workforce and  
10 further education; and

11 WHEREAS, career and technical student organizations in Georgia are an integral part of and  
12 intra-curricular component for career, technical, and agricultural education programs, which  
13 are designed to support instructional objectives and the attainment of academic and technical  
14 competencies; and

15 WHEREAS, they provide an opportunity for students not only to gain confidence and  
16 knowledge through competition but also to become more motivated in becoming better  
17 students and more productive citizens, which in turn develops school and community leaders.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
19 the members of this body recognize February 2023 as Career and Technical Education  
20 Month and February 23, 2023, as Georgia Career and Technical Student Organizations Day  
21 at the state capitol.
