## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the Georgia High School Fencing League (GHSFL) and its member teams; and for
- 2 other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, the GHSFL offers the organization, support, and guidance to high schools
- 4 wishing to develop a fencing program, providing students the opportunity to participate in
- 5 a classical sport that demands physical fitness and teaches patience and decisiveness; and
- 6 WHEREAS, USA Fencing, the sport's national governing body, recognizes the GHSFL as
- 7 the fastest growing high school fencing league in the United States, and as the third largest
- 8 such league in the United States; and
- 9 WHEREAS, from a field of over 400 fencers who participated in the 2016-2017 GHSFL
- season tournaments, 84 men and 77 women attending 18 of the 20 high schools in the league
- were among those who qualified to participate in the 2017 Individual Championships hosted
- 12 by Alpharetta High School on January 28, 2017; and
- 13 WHEREAS, in both the men's and women's competitions, the top eight finalists were
- 14 awarded individual championship medals; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Roswell High School fencer Anthony Martin captured 1st in the men's
- 16 competition and Kevin Feng of Johns Creek High School finished 2nd; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Alpharetta High School fencer Arthur Yu and Chance Gilbreth of Northview
- 18 High School tied for 3rd place, and rounding out the top eight were Eden Hilton of Lassiter
- 19 High School in 5th place, Patrick Malloy of Northview High School in 6th, Caleb Colburn
- 20 of Alpharetta High School in 7th, and Amith Vadlamudi of Milton High School in 8th; and
- 21 WHEREAS, in the women's competition, Elaine Wen of North Springs High School and
- 22 Caroline Kwon of Johns Creek High School won 1st and 2nd place, respectively, and

23 Chattahoochee High School's Jeannie Lee and Ana Cristian of Pope High School tied for 3rd

- 25 WHEREAS, Elina Moon of Chattahoochee High School finished in 5th place, and Haley
- 26 Tinsley of Alpharetta High School in 6th, Amy Ahn of South Forsyth High School in 7th,
- and Maggie Fritts of Centennial High School in 8th; and
- 28 WHEREAS the team championships were held at Pope High School on February 4, 2017,
- and in both the men's and women's competitions, the top four teams were awarded team
- 30 championship trophies; and
- 31 WHEREAS, the Northview High School team of Patrick Malloy, Chance Gilbreth, Joshua
- 32 Jeon, and Alex Kim captured 1st place in men's competition, while the Pope High School
- 33 team of Ana Cristian, Lyndsay Wagner, Ellie Fayet, and Rebecca Xhajanka won 1st place
- 34 in women's competition; and
- 35 WHEREAS, the teams from Alpharetta High School (Caleb Colburn, Derek Wang, Russell
- 36 Lea, and Joshua Ng), Centennial High School (Nick Bray, Jermain Leon, Daniel Sandfelder,
- 37 and Quinn Harrison), and Lassiter High School (Eden Hilton, Joe Gonzalez, Kai Weissman,
- and Dakota Smith) finished in 2nd, 3rd, and 4th place, respectively, in the men's competition,
- 39 and in the women's competition the Chattahoochee High School team (Elina Moon, Jeannie
- 40 Lee, Annabel Hsu, and Samantha Yvellez) captured 2nd place, South Forsyth High School
- 41 (Amy Ahn, Mary Zhou, Carly Butler, and Ariana Wang) took 3rd place, and Creek High
- 42 School (Caroline Kwon, Rita Wang, Angie Chen, and Christine Cheng) finished in 4th place.
- 43 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 44 the members of this body honor the Georgia High School Fencing League (GHSFL) and its
- 45 member teams and express their support for the continued growth of the sport of fencing
