A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commemorating the 76th anniversary of National Disability Employment
- 2 Awareness Month and the 31st anniversary of the enactment of the Americans with
- 3 Disabilities Act of 1990; and for other purposes.
- 4 WHEREAS, October 2021 marks the 76th anniversary of National Disability Employment
- 5 Awareness Month; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the purpose of National Disability Employment Awareness Month is to educate
- 7 about disability employment issues and celebrate the many and varied contributions of
- 8 America's workers with disabilities; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the history of National Disability Employment Awareness Month traces back
- 10 to 1945 when Congress enacted a law declaring the first week in October each year as
- 11 "National Employ the Physically Handicapped Week"; and
- WHEREAS, in 1962, the word "physically" was removed to acknowledge the employment
- 13 needs and contributions of individuals with all types of disabilities, and in 1988, Congress
- 14 expanded the week to a month and changed the name to National Disability Employment
- 15 Awareness Month; and

16 WHEREAS, workplaces welcoming of the talents of all people, including people with

- 17 disabilities, are a critical part of our efforts to build an inclusive community and strong
- 18 economy; and
- 19 WHEREAS, activities during this month will reinforce the value and talent people with
- 20 disabilities add to our workplaces and communities and affirm Georgia's commitment to an
- 21 inclusive community that increases access and opportunities to all, including individuals with
- 22 disabilities; and
- 23 WHEREAS, July 26, 2021, marked the 31st anniversary of the enactment of the Americans
- 24 with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA); and
- 25 WHEREAS, prior to the enactment of the ADA, people with disabilities were often
- 26 segregated and denied equality of opportunity based on fear, ignorance, prejudice,
- 27 stereotypes, labels, and pernicious mythologies; and
- 28 WHEREAS, the ADA rejects these precepts and instead embraces the precept that disability
- 29 is a natural and normal part of the human experience that in no way diminishes a person's
- 30 right to fully participate in all aspects of society; and
- 31 WHEREAS, the ADA has played a historic role in enabling people with disabilities to fully
- 32 participate in all aspects of society by removing barriers to employment, public services,
- 33 public accommodations, public and private transportation, telework, telecommunications,
- 34 and more; and

35 WHEREAS, every person in the United States, not just people with disabilities, benefit from

- 36 covered entities adopting principles of universal design with respect to buildings, modes of
- 37 transportation, websites, and other technologies procured and used by covered entities.
- 38 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 39 the members of this body recognize and commemorate the 76th anniversary of National
- 40 Disability Employment Awareness Month and the 31st anniversary of the enactment of the
- 41 Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990.
- 42 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
- 44 public and the press.
