A RESOLUTION

- 1 Creating the House Study Committee on Inclusive Postsecondary Education; and for other
- 2 purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, postsecondary educational opportunities have the same benefits for individuals
- 4 with intellectual and developmental disabilities as they do for traditional students: academic
- 5 and personal skills building, independence, self-advocacy, friendships, and employment
- 6 skills; and
- 7 WHEREAS, inclusive postsecondary programs provide opportunities for students with
- 8 intellectual and developmental disabilities to further their education beyond high school,
- 9 which prepares them to blossom in their careers and lives; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Georgians with disabilities want jobs and careers, but the current system
- 11 disincentivizes employment; and
- WHEREAS, the continued development of options for those with disabilities would benefit
- 13 those individuals and their families, Georgia employers, and Georgia taxpayers; and
- 14 WHEREAS, it is worthwhile to consider and study whether the technical college system
- 15 could develop and maintain a program or programs to provide students with intellectual and
- developmental disabilities with useful skills that allow them to achieve their full potential.
- 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 18 GEORGIA:
- 19 (1) **Creation of House study committee.** There is created the House Study Committee
- on Inclusive Postsecondary Education.
- 21 (2) Members and officers.
- 22 (A) The committee shall be composed of five members.

23 (B) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint five members of the 24 House of Representatives as members of the committee and shall designate one of such

- 25 members as chairperson.
- 26 (3) **Powers and duties.** The committee shall undertake a study of the conditions, needs,
- issues, and problems mentioned above or related thereto and recommend any action or
- legislation which the committee deems necessary or appropriate.
- 29 (4) **Meetings.** The chairperson shall call all meetings of the committee. The committee
- may conduct such meetings at such places and at such times as it may deem necessary or
- 31 convenient to enable it to exercise fully and effectively its powers, perform its duties, and
- accomplish the objectives and purposes of this resolution.

33 (5) Allowances and funding.

- 34 (A) The legislative members of the committee shall receive the allowances provided
- for in Code Section 28-1-8 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated.
- 36 (B) The allowances authorized by this resolution shall not be received by any member
- of the committee for more than five days unless additional days are authorized. Funds
- necessary to carry out the provisions of this resolution shall come from funds
- appropriated to the House of Representatives.

(6) Report.

- 41 (A) In the event the committee adopts any specific findings or recommendations that
- include suggestions for proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file a report of the
- same prior to the date of abolishment specified in this resolution, subject to
- subparagraph (C) of this paragraph.
- (B) In the event the committee adopts a report that does not include suggestions for
- proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file the report, subject to subparagraph (C)
- 47 of this paragraph.
- 48 (C) No report shall be filed unless the same has been approved prior to the date of
- abolishment specified in this resolution by majority vote of a quorum of the committee.
- A report so approved shall be signed by the chairperson of the committee and filed with
- 51 the Clerk of the House of Representatives.
- 52 (D) In the absence of an approved report, the chairperson may file with the Clerk of the
- House of Representatives copies of the minutes of the meetings of the committee in lieu
- 54 thereof.
- 55 (7) **Abolishment.** The committee shall stand abolished on December 1, 2017.
