## A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life of Corporal Richard "Ricky" Allen Hall and dedicating a bridge in his  
2 memory; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia lost one of its finest citizens and most dedicated law  
4 enforcement officers with the tragic passing of Corporal Richard "Ricky" Allen Hall on  
5 September 16, 2015; and

6 WHEREAS, Corporal Hall served as a member of the Chatham County Sheriff's Department  
7 and his life was tragically cut short after an automobile accident in Bryan County; and

8 WHEREAS, a native of Savannah, Corporal Hall graduated from Tompkins High School,  
9 attended South University, and served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty with  
10 the United States Marine Corps; and

11 WHEREAS, Corporal Hall dedicated 14 years to protecting and serving the people of  
12 Chatham County with the Sheriff's Department; and

13 WHEREAS, he exhibited extraordinary devotion to duty, outstanding loyalty, fine  
14 leadership, and meticulous attention to detail in all his duties; and

15 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished  
16 Georgian be recognized appropriately by dedicating a bridge in his honor.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL  
18 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the I-16 overpass bridge on SR 30/US 80/280 in Bryan  
19 County is dedicated as the Corporal Rick Hall Memorial Bridge.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and  
21 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Corporal Rick Hall Memorial  
22 Bridge.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
24 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the  
25 family of Corporal Richard "Ricky" Allen Hall and to the Department of Transportation.
