- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Thomas Livsey; and for other purposes.

3 with the passing of Thomas Livsey on December 5, 2023; and
- 4 WHEREAS, a native of Promised Land, South Carolina, he was recognized by his fellow  
5 citizens as a natural leader whose efforts to revitalize the town earned him the title of  
6 "unofficial mayor" and have left an enduring legacy of service; and
- 7 WHEREAS, he further served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty with the  
8 United States Army, valiantly and courageously protecting his fellow Americans during the  
9 Korean War; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Thomas was blessed with five remarkable children, five wonderful  
11 grandchildren, and nine outstanding great-grandchildren; and
- 12 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern  
13 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his  
14 family and friends were admired by others; and

15 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation  
16 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example he made of his life, he  
17 made this world a better place in which to live; and

18 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Thomas will long be remembered for his  
19 love of family, friendship, and community and will be missed by all who had the great  
20 fortune of knowing him.
