A RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution so as to provide that persons who are 17 years
- 2 of age and older may register to vote and vote in elections in this state; to provide for related
- 3 matters; to provide for the submission of this amendment for ratification or rejection; and for
- 4 other purposes.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Article II, Section I of the Constitution is amended by revising Paragraph II as follows:
- 8 "Paragraph II. *Right to register and vote.* Every person who is a citizen of the United
- 9 States and a resident of Georgia as defined by law, who is at least 18 17 years of age and
- 10 not disenfranchised by this article, and who meets minimum residency requirements as
- provided by law shall be entitled to vote at any election by the people. The General
- 12 Assembly shall provide by law for the registration of electors."

13 SECTION 2.

- 14 The above proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be published and submitted as
- provided in Article X, Section I, Paragraph II of the Constitution. The ballot submitting the
- above proposed amendment shall have written or printed thereon the following:
- 17 "() YES Shall the Constitution of Georgia be amended so as to provide that persons
- 18 () NO who are 17 years of age and older may register to vote and vote in elections
- in this state?"
- 20 All persons desiring to vote in favor of ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "Yes."
- 21 All persons desiring to vote against ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "No." If
- such amendment shall be ratified as provided in said Paragraph of the Constitution, it shall
- 23 become a part of the Constitution of this state.
