- 13 WHEREAS, from the time of their initial police chief training provided by the Georgia

- 16 effectiveness through cooperation with state, county, and local governmental officials; and
- 17 WHEREAS, police chiefs and heads of law enforcement agencies of Georgia support the
- 18 continuous elevation of standards and training of law enforcement managers and have been
- 19 instrumental in increasing the public's awareness of methods for avoiding being victims of
- 20 crime; and
