A RESOLUTION

- 1 Congratulating and commending Tamara Carrera for receiving the 2021 Yellow Rose Nikki
- 2 T. Randall Servant Leader Award; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, in 1999, Representative Nikki T. Randall became the first African American
- 4 female elected to the General Assembly from middle Georgia, and over her 17 years of
- 5 service as a legislator, she held numerous leadership positions, including chair of the Georgia
- 6 Legislative Women's Caucus; and
- 7 WHEREAS, every year during Women's History Month, the Georgia Legislative Women's
- 8 Caucus recognizes outstanding women in Georgia who exemplify the leadership and
- 9 inspiration embodied by Representative Randall; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Tamara Carrera began as a volunteer for Community Assistance Center (CAC)
- in 1992 and was promoted and appointed as the chief executive officer of CAC in 1997. She
- 12 has led CAC to become a model of community partnership in preventing homelessness,
- 13 reducing hunger, and promoting self-sufficiency for those in need; and

14 WHEREAS, throughout her career, she has dutifully served on several boards, including

- 15 most recently the Horizons Enrichment Program, Holy Innocents Episcopal School,
- 16 Leadership Sandy Springs, Sandy Springs Education Force, and Second Helpings; and
- 17 WHEREAS, she has been recognized by industry leaders to be a visionary and strategic
- 18 thinker who leads by example to establish organizational excellence and implement
- 19 meaningful programs that deliver consistent and measurable outcomes. She is known as a
- 20 bridge builder and as someone who develops strategic alliances, developing effective and
- 21 efficient programs. She also is widely praised for her mentorship of fellow nonprofit leaders;
- 22 and
- 23 WHEREAS, because of CAC's expansion under Tamara's leadership, she and her team were
- 24 able to spring into action when the COVID-19 pandemic emerged. CAC has focused on
- 25 serving families and individuals who have been hit the hardest by loss of income due to the
- 26 economic crisis. In 2020, the CAC gave more than \$2 million in emergency financial
- 27 assistance for rent and utilities, helping 1,348 families, a 598 percent increase from 2019.
- 28 CAC gave food to 6,452 individuals from 2,215 households, a 44 percent increase from
- 29 2019. And they distributed 54,659 lunches to children and delivered weekly food to senior
- 30 citizens and medically fragile or home-bound individuals; and
- 31 WHEREAS, in late 2020, Tamara announced she would be retiring from her position at CAC
- 32 in early 2021. Tamara's contributions to the Sandy Springs community are immeasurable,
- and all will feel her absence.
