A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the contribution and leadership of Gwinnett Chief of Police J.D. McClure; and for
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, J.D. McClure became Chief of Police of the Gwinnett County Police
4 Department in August 2021; and

5 WHEREAS, Gwinnett Chief of Police J.D. McClure previously served as deputy chief,
6 commanding the department's Operations Bureau; and

7 WHEREAS, he was appointed to major in 2016, where he served as the Central Precinct
8 commander and the department's chief of staff; and

9 WHEREAS, Gwinnett Chief of Police J.D. McClure was also a dedicated member of the
10 Special Weapons and Tactics Team for more than a decade, retiring as the tactical team
11 leader; and

12 WHEREAS, he was promoted to lieutenant in September 2009, where he served as
13 commander of the Criminal Investigations Division, watch commander in the Criminal
14 Investigations Section, and as the commander of the Office of Professional Standards; and

15 WHEREAS, Gwinnett Chief of Police J.D. McClure began his career as a police officer with
16 the Gwinnett County Police Department in September 1996 as a member of the 36th Police
17 Academy; and

18 WHEREAS, he obtained an associate's degree in criminal justice and is a proud veteran of
19 the United States Marine Corps.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
21 the members of this body honor the contributions and leadership of Gwinnett Chief of Police
22 J.D. McClure.
