A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing March 13, 2017, as Valdosta State University Day at the state capitol and
2 commending student leaders at Valdosta State University; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Valdosta State University has been serving the citizens of South Georgia for
4 more than 100 years and continues to be dedicated to educating leaders for the 21st century;

6 WHEREAS, these students represent the approximately 11,300 undergraduate and graduate
7 students within Valdosta State University and are actively engaged in research and scholarly
8 activities with faculty members within their selected disciplines; and

9 WHEREAS, it is Valdosta State University's mission to provide the highest quality
10 undergraduate and master's level programs, along with expanded doctoral degrees; and

11 WHEREAS, Valdosta State University's faculty are engaged in scholarly activities, including
12 published papers in national and international peer-reviewed journals, co-authored books,
13 research presentations, and juried exhibits; and

14 WHEREAS, Valdosta State University is a comprehensive university offering degrees in
15 more than 100 majors and a major employer with an economic impact of more than \$400
16 million annually; and

17 WHEREAS, Valdosta State University serves as the regional center for the arts in South
18 Georgia, providing 25 years of professional classical music through the Valdosta Symphony
19 Orchestra and professional theater performances through Peach State Summer Theater; and

20 WHEREAS, the Valdosta State University Blazers boast an impressive seven NCAA
21 Division II national championships in baseball, men's tennis, softball, and football.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
23 the members of this body recognize March 13, 2017, as Valdosta State University Day at the
24 state capitol and commend student leaders at Valdosta State University for their commitment
25 to and advocacy for the causes of their institution.
