- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens
3 with the passing of Comer H. Flynn on February 3, 2021; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Comer H. Flynn was born on October 14, 1939, in Savannah, Georgia, a
5 beloved son of Joseph and Viola Luten Flynn; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he was united in love and marriage to his wife of 56 years, Betty, and was
7 blessed with one remarkable daughter, Comia, and a wonderful granddaughter, Taylor; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Comer attended Savannah State College, where he received his Bachelor of
9 Science, and then successfully pursued higher education at Georgia Southern College,
10 Cambridge College, and Lincoln Memorial, where he earned an education specialist degree;

- 12 WHEREAS, a highly respected educator in the Savannah Chatham County Public School
13 System, he established a distinguished record of expertise and was well known for his
14 generosity to his colleagues, associates, and students during his 43 years of superlative

15 service with several academic institutions, including Windsor Forest High School, Jenkins
16 High School, and the Scott Alternative Center; and

17 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern
18 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his
19 family and friends were admired by others; and

20 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Comer H. Flynn will long be remembered
21 for his love of family, friendship, and community and will be missed by all who had the great
22 fortune of knowing him.
