A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing October 15, 2023, as White Cane Awareness Day; and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, the white cane, which every blind citizen of our state/city has the right to carry,
demonstrates and symbolizes the ability to achieve a full and independent life and the
capacity to work productively in competitive employment; and

5 WHEREAS, by allowing every blind person to move freely and safely from place to place, 6 the white cane and guide dogs make it possible for the blind to fully participate in and 7 contribute to our society and to live the lives they want; and

8 WHEREAS, every citizen should be aware that the law requires that motorists and cyclists
9 exercise appropriate caution when approaching a blind person carrying a white cane or using
10 a guide dog; and

WHEREAS, Georgia law also calls upon employers, both public and private, to be aware of and utilize the employment skills of our blind citizens by recognizing their worth as individuals and their productive capacities; and WHEREAS, the State of Georgia, through its public agencies and with the cooperative assistance of the National Federation of the Blind of Georgia and the Georgia Council of the Blind, can and should facilitate the expansion of employment opportunities for and greater acceptance of blind persons in the competitive labor market.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that

the members of this body call upon our schools, colleges, and universities to offer full opportunities for training to blind persons; upon employers and the public to utilize the available skills of competent blind persons and to open new opportunities for the blind in our rapidly changing society; and upon all citizens to recognize the white cane and guide dog as tools of independence for blind pedestrians on our streets and highways.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the members of this body recognize October 15, 2023,
as White Cane Awareness Day.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
public and the press.
