A RESOLUTION

- 1 Encouraging local boards of education to conduct annual screenings of the film *America*:
- 2 Imagine the World Without Her for students in eighth grade and eleventh grade; and for other
- 3 purposes.
- 4 WHEREAS, Dinesh D'Souza created the film *America: Imagine the World Without Her* to
- 5 combat the idea that America is a "disgrace" to the world, a message that "is consistently
- 6 drummed into our young people in our schools and our colleges," D'Souza said; and
- 7 WHEREAS, he said the film analyzes common critiques of the country's past, like slavery
- 8 and the treatment of Native Americans, and "zooms in on them to see which parts are true
- 9 and which are completely false"; and
- 10 WHEREAS, D'Souza, who was born and raised in India before immigrating to the United
- 11 States, has made an 80-minute educational version of the film that eliminates interviews with
- 12 political pundits so that it contains "purely historical content."
- 13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 14 this body encourages local boards of education to conduct annual screenings of the film
- 15 America: Imagine the World Without Her for students in eighth grade and eleventh grade.
- 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to local
- 18 boards of education.
