A RESOLUTION

1 Congratulating and commending Sarah E. Stottlemeyer for receiving the 2023 Yellow Rose
2 Nikki T. Randall Servant Leader Award; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, in 1999, Representative Nikki T. Randall became the first African American
4 female elected to the General Assembly from middle Georgia, and over her 17 years of
5 service as a legislator, she held numerous leadership positions, including chair of the Georgia
6 Legislative Women's Caucus; and

7 WHEREAS, every year during Women's History Month, the Georgia Legislative Women's
8 Caucus recognizes outstanding women in Georgia who exemplify the leadership and
9 inspiration embodied by Representative Randall; and

10 WHEREAS, Sarah E. Stottlemeyer currently serves as the president of the Georgia Workers'
11 Compensation Claimant's Lawyers' Association, the immediate past-president of the
12 Workers' Compensation Section of the Atlanta Bar Association, member of the Executive
13 Committee of the Workers' Injury Law Group, and more; and

14 WHEREAS, as testament to her service to those in-need, her 501(c)(3) nonprofit
15 organization Holiday Helping Hands Inc. provides the children of injured workers with

16 presents during the holiday season, supporting more than 250 children annually who would
17 otherwise go without during the holidays; and

18 WHEREAS, recognized annually since 2014 as a Super Lawyer, Sarah E. Stottlemyer has
19 been featured as a fighter for women and injured workers' families in *Atlanta Attorney At*
20 *Law Magazine* and *The Atlantan Magazine's* Dynamic Women of Atlanta; and

21 WHEREAS, Sarah E. Stottlemyer is a woman of unassuming greatness whose humble acts
22 of kindness and generosity have uplifted the entire Atlanta community; and

23 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
24 extraordinary servant leader be appropriately recognized.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
26 the members of this body congratulate and commend Sarah E. Stottlemyer for receiving
27 the 2023 Yellow Rose Nikki T. Randall Servant Leader Award and extend best wishes for
