- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Dinah Katharine Culbreath Wayne; and for other purposes.

3 with the passing of Dinah Katharine Culbreath Wayne on January 20, 2021, at the age of 77;

6 Florida, a beloved daughter of Melvin and Beatrice Culbreath; and
- 7 WHEREAS, a dedicated member of the community, she was the driving force for the
8 rehabilitation of the historic Flowery Branch Depot and coordinated the ratification of the
9 Historic Preservation Ordinance, naming a commission and a historic district; and
- 10 WHEREAS, this distinguished gentlewoman further served on many boards, foundations,
11 and commissions, including the Flowery Branch Historic Preservation Commission, the
12 Lanier Technical College Foundation Board, Flowery Branch Better Hometown Inc., Friends
13 of the Depot Inc., and more; and

14 WHEREAS, she was united in love and marriage to her husband, Alan, and was blessed with
15 two remarkable children, Alex and Daren, as well as six wonderful grandchildren, Braden,
16 Mackenzie, Garrett, Bennett, Jack, and Oliver; and

17 WHEREAS, Dinah gave inspiration to many through her high ideals, morals, and deep
18 concern for her fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding she
19 demonstrated to her family and friends were admired by others; and

20 WHEREAS, she was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
21 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example she made of her life,
22 she made this world a better place in which to live; and

23 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous woman, Dinah Katharine Culbreath Wayne will
24 long be remembered for her love of family, friendship, and community and will be missed
25 by all who had the great fortune of knowing her.
