21 WHEREAS, Marjorie's recent work with the Minimally Invasive Center of Atlanta, a center
22 dedicated to nonsurgical options for certain treatments, combined with and her vision and

23 unyielding commitment to educating women on options about their health have set the
24 standard for public service; and

26 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
