## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Creating the House Study Committee on Mental Health and Substance Use Disorder; and for
- 2 other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, mental illnesses are among the most common health conditions in the United
- 4 States; and
- 5 WHEREAS, substance use and addiction can contribute to the development of mental illness;
- 6 and
- 7 WHEREAS, over 2.3 million individuals live with mental illness, yet Georgia ranks 47 out
- 8 of 50 states for access to mental health care, resources, and insurance; and
- 9 WHEREAS, more than 340,000 adults and 100,000 children in Georgia live with serious
- 10 mental health conditions; and
- WHEREAS, in Georgia, an individual with serious mental illness has a one in five chance
- 12 of ending up in prison instead of a hospital; and

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WHEREAS, addiction to drugs and alcohol is a mental illness better known as "substance

- 14 use disorder"; and
- 15 WHEREAS, drug overdose is the leading cause of accidental deaths in the United States,
- with opioids being the most common drug; and
- 17 WHEREAS, it would be beneficial to explore ways to ensure greater partnership between
- 18 nonprofit organizations and agencies to provide greater services, identify the best
- 19 investments and best practices in mental health and substance use disorders, and determine
- 20 the optimal use of funding to best serve our communities.
- 21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:
- 22 (1) **Creation of House study committee.** There is created the House Study Committee
- on Mental Health and Substance Use Disorder.
- 24 (2) **Members and officers.** The committee shall be composed of five members of the
- 25 House of Representatives to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of
- 26 Representatives. The Speaker shall designate a member of the committee as chairperson
- of the committee.
- 28 (3) **Powers and duties.** The committee shall undertake a study of the conditions, needs,
- issues, and problems mentioned above or related thereto and recommend any action or
- legislation which the committee deems necessary or appropriate.
- 31 (4) **Meetings.** The chairperson shall call all meetings of the committee. The committee
- may conduct such meetings at such places and at such times as it may deem necessary or
- convenient to enable it to exercise fully and effectively its powers, perform its duties, and
- accomplish the objectives and purposes of this resolution.
- 35 (5) **Allowances and funding.** The legislative members of the committee shall receive
- 36 the allowances provided for in Code Section 28-1-8 of the Official Code of Georgia

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Annotated. The allowances authorized by this resolution shall not be received by any

- member of the committee for more than five days unless additional days are authorized.
- Funds necessary to carry out the provisions of this resolution shall come from funds
- appropriated to the House of Representatives.

## 41 (6) **Report.**

- 42 (A) In the event the committee adopts any specific findings or recommendations that
- include suggestions for proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file a report of the
- same prior to the date of abolishment specified in this resolution, subject to
- subparagraph (C) of this paragraph.
- 46 (B) In the event the committee adopts a report that does not include suggestions for
- proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file the report, subject to subparagraph (C)
- of this paragraph.
- 49 (C) No report shall be filed unless the same has been approved prior to the date of
- abolishment specified in this resolution by majority vote of a quorum of the committee.
- A report so approved shall be signed by the chairperson of the committee and filed with
- the Clerk of the House of Representatives.
- (D) In the absence of an approved report, the chairperson may file with the Clerk of the
- House of Representatives a copy of the minutes of the meetings of the committee in lieu
- 55 thereof.
- 56 (7) **Abolishment.** The committee shall stand abolished on December 1, 2021.
