13 remarkable children, Andrew and Laura; and three wonderful grandchildren, Caroline,

- 15 WHEREAS, this outstanding Georgia citizen had a successful career with NorthWestern
16 Mutual Life Insurance Company for 48 years and was deeply adored by his friends and
17 colleagues there; and
- 18 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern
19 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his
20 family and friends were admired by others; and

21 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
22 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example he made of his life, he

25 love of family, traveling, and the Georgia Bulldogs and will be missed by all who had the
