A RESOLUTION

1 Congratulating the Forest City Juniors of the Forest City Gun Club for winning the 2022
2 Scholastic Clay Target Program National Championship; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Forest City Juniors have established and maintained a proud tradition of
4 excellence with equal emphases on character, discipline, and academics; and

5 WHEREAS, excellent play, superior teamwork, extraordinary resilience, and much certitude
6 made these juniors spectacular to observe throughout the season, and as a fitting finale to
7 their remarkable 2022 campaign, they captured an unprecedented third straight national
8 championship; and

9 WHEREAS, led by Dawson Williams, Jackson Schaaf, Rich Pazderski, Jake Kinlaw, Owen
10 Haas, and Jackson Ferland, the Forest City Juniors won by an impressive 29 targets over the
11 Allen Eagles from the State of Texas, shooting 2,122 out of 2,200 total targets; and

12 WHEREAS, senior Rich Pazderski earned further recognition as the Individual National
13 HOA Champion, becoming the first ever Forest City Junior to attain that honor; and

14 WHEREAS, the event consisted of girls and boys from elementary schools, middle schools,

16 disciplines: skeet, trap, and sporting clays; and

17 WHEREAS, as the Forest City Juniors earned their well-deserved reputation for excellence
18 by performing with courage and precision over months of training and competition, it is
19 abundantly proper to call them champions.

21 the members of this body congratulate the Forest City Juniors for winning the 2022
22 Scholastic Clay Target Program National Championship and extend best wishes for
