- of the Usher Board, president of the choir, a member of the Deaconess Board, and a faithful

- 14 Church Mother until her untimely demise; and

- in 1995, she founded and directed the Children of God gospel group, which consisted of her

- 20 Division and later pursued her passion for caring for others by establishing her home child
- 21 care, B.E. Toddler's Land, in 1995; and
- WHEREAS, she gave inspiration to many through her high ideals, morals, and deep concern
- 23 for her fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding she demonstrated to
- 24 her family and friends were admired by others; and
- 25 WHEREAS, she was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
- 26 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example she made of her life,
- 27 she made this world a better place in which to live; and
- 28 WHEREAS, she possessed the vast wisdom which only comes through experience and the
- 29 strength of character which is achieved by overcoming the many challenges of life; and
- 30 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous woman, Mother Shuman will long be
- 31 remembered for her love of family, friendship, and community and will be missed by all who
- 32 had the great fortune of knowing her.
