- 3 with the passing of Deputy Justin White on November 15, 2016, when he was killed in the
- 4 line of duty; and

- 6 was later mandated as a sworn officer on March 27, 2015; and
- WHEREAS, he served as Deputy Sheriff until his death on November 15, 2016; and

- 9 people he served. During his career, his passion was assisting in domestic violence cases;

- 12 cardiac arrest after a car accident; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Deputy White himself passed away due to injuries from a car accident as he was
- 14 en route to attempt to save another life that was in cardiac arrest; and
- 15 WHEREAS, the courageous and selfless response of Deputy White were nothing short of
- 16 heroic, he exemplified the bravery and honor that law enforcement officers across the State
- 17 of Georgia and nationwide display every day; and
- 18 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Deputy Justin White will long be
- 19 remembered for his love of family, friendship, and keeping the community safe and will be
- 20 missed by all who had the great fortune of knowing him.
