A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life of Chief W. Lynn Taylor and dedicating an intersection in his memory; and
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Chief W. Lynn Taylor served as the Director of Public Safety and Chief of
4 Police for Waycross, Georgia, from 1978 until 2001; and

5 WHEREAS, Chief Taylor returned to public service after his retirement from law
6 enforcement in 2001 to serve as city commissioner from 2004 to 2007; and

7 WHEREAS, he exhibited extraordinary devotion to duty, outstanding loyalty, fine
8 leadership, and meticulous attention to detail in all his duties; and

9 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished
10 Georgian be recognized appropriately by dedicating an intersection in his honor.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
12 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the intersection of State Route 4/US 1 South at South Point
13 Mall and the Waycross Market Place entrances in Ware County is dedicated as the Lynn
14 Taylor Crossing.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
16 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Lynn Taylor Crossing.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
18 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
19 family of Chief W. Lynn Taylor and to the Department of Transportation.
