A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending the State of Israel and condemning anti-Semitism in all its forms; and for other
- 2 purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, there has been a disturbing increase in anti-Semitism world wide, nationally,
- 4 and locally where Jewish populations are facing increased levels of hatred; and
- 5 WHEREAS, prejudice against Jews as a national, ethnic, religious, or racial group has no
- 6 place in Georgia or in the United States of America; and
- 7 WHEREAS, anti-Semitism is a challenge to the basic principles of tolerance, pluralism, and
- 8 democracy and the shared values that bind Americans together; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the United States and Israel have a long relationship and close alliance, each
- 10 attempting to support the interests of the other; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the State of Israel, the only democracy in the Middle East, is the greatest friend
- 12 and ally of the United States in that region; and
- 13 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia is proud to be home to the Consulate General of Israel in
- 14 Atlanta and reaffirms our esteem for the Consul General of Israel to the Southeastern United
- 15 States; and
- 16 WHEREAS, there is an urgent need to ensure the safety and security of Jewish communities,
- 17 including synagogues, schools, cemeteries, and other institutions; and
- 18 WHEREAS, it is in the foreign policy interest of the United States to continue to emphasize
- 19 the importance of combating anti-Semitism in our bilateral and multilateral relations,
- 20 including with the United Nations, European Union institutions, Arab League, and the
- 21 Organization for Security and Cooperation in Europe; and

WHEREAS, it is important to the national security interest of the United States to maintain

- 23 strong bipartisan support for Israel, the only democracy in the Middle East, all attempts to
- 24 delegitimize and deny Israel's right to exist must be denounced and rejected; and
- 25 WHEREAS, it is in the national security interest of the United States to oppose restrictive
- 26 trade practices or boycotts fostered or imposed by any foreign country against other countries
- 27 friendly to the United States or against any United States person.
- 28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 29 the members of this body oppose all forms of racism and hatred, including anti-Semitism;
- 30 oppose attempts to deny the legitimacy of Israel as a sovereign state; commend Israel for its
- 31 cordial and mutually beneficial relationship with the United States and with the State of
- 32 Georgia; and support Israel in its legal, historical, moral, and God-given right of
- 33 self-governance and self-defense.
- 34 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
- 36 Israeli Ambassador to the United States, the Honorable Consul General, and the Georgia
- 37 congressional delegation.
