A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Cornerstone Christian Academy; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Cornerstone created an environment of hands-on exploration for its students in
3 STEM related curriculum; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Cornerstone fostered problem solving, critical thinking, and creativity through
5 designing, building, and programming robots; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Cornerstone cultivated perseverance through "challenge-based" learning that
7 required students to test potential solutions; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Cornerstone promoted collaborative projects that encouraged students to
9 evaluate one another's strengths to effectively divide responsibilities; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Cornerstone stimulated student literacy by infusing STEM vocabulary into the
11 curriculum; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Cornerstone understood that early exposure to STEM curriculum produces
13 confidence and connections to core math and science education; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Cornerstone was recognized by Technology Association of Georgia (TAG) as
15 one of six finalists for the 2014 Middle School STEM Education Award out of 150 middle
16 school applicants in the state.
