- 1 Recognizing Mr. Frank "Poppa D." Delaney, Jr., and dedicating a road in his honor; and for
- 2 other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, Mr. Frank "Poppa D." Delaney, Jr., was employed by the Thomas County
- 4 School System in 1969 and assigned to East Ochlocknee School where he served as teacher
- 5 and acting principal; and
- 6 WHEREAS, following the full integration of schools in Thomas County in 1970, he served
- 7 as a math teacher at Central High School in Thomas County until he was named assistant
- 8 principal in 1972; and
- 9 WHEREAS, he was instrumental in being a strong public example, as well as working
- 10 diligently behind the scenes, to help ensure a smooth transition for Thomas County's families
- and their children and was one of the primary steadying forces during the tumultuous years
- 12 of school desegregation; and
- WHEREAS, he served as high school assistant principal from 1972 to 1993, earning the love,
- 14 respect, and admiration of thousands of Thomas County students; and
- 15 WHEREAS, in 1993, he was named principal of Thomas County Central High School,
- 16 devotedly leading thousands of children of Thomas County, until his retirement in 2008; and
- 17 WHEREAS, when called upon by the school district in a time of need, he returned to the
- school system in 2011 to serve Thomas County Central High School as dean of students and
- 19 principal emeritus; and
- 20 WHEREAS, he has led students, teachers, and the community at large with his uncanny
- 21 wisdom, his powerful sincerity, and his gracious good humor; and

22 WHEREAS, affectionately known by the entire county as "Poppa D.," Mr. Delaney is

- 23 considered one of the cornerstones of community influence by all of the citizens within
- 24 Thomas County; and
- 25 WHEREAS, the citizens of Thomas County desire to establish a lasting tribute to one whose
- 26 career spans nearly half a century and has become part of the very fabric of Thomas County,
- 27 born and raised on Pebble Hill Plantation and spending his entire adult life working with the
- 28 Thomas County School System; and
- 29 WHEREAS, he has steadfastly placed God and family as the centerpieces of his leadership
- 30 philosophy, never shying away from an opportunity to lead people toward one while always
- 31 making sure to include them as part of the other; and
- 32 WHEREAS, he has been honored by innumerable social and civic organizations for his
- 33 invaluable service to tens of thousands of Thomas County citizens; and
- 34 WHEREAS, his legacy will continue to impact the development of Thomas County for many
- 35 generations to come; and
- 36 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished
- 37 Georgian be recognized appropriately by dedicating a road in his honor.
- 38 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
- 39 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the portion of US Highway 84 Bypass from Thomas
- 40 County Central High School to Thomas County Middle School in Thomas County is
- 41 dedicated as the Frank "Poppa D." Delaney, Jr., Parkway.
- 42 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
- 43 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Frank "Poppa D." Delaney,
- 44 Jr., Parkway.
- 45 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to Mr.
- 47 Frank "Poppa D." Delaney, Jr., and to the Department of Transportation.
