#### A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life of Trooper Clyde Arthur Wehunt and dedicating a road in his memory; and  
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia lost one of its finest citizens and most dedicated law  
4 enforcement officers with the tragic passing of Trooper Clyde Arthur Wehunt on April 20,  
5 1951; and

6 WHEREAS, a native of Canton, Georgia, Trooper Wehunt attended the 12th Trooper School  
7 and was assigned to service at Post 27 in Blue Ridge; and

8 WHEREAS, this dedicated law enforcement officer's life was cut short after a patrol car  
9 crash on Ga. 5 in Fannin County; and

10 WHEREAS, Trooper Wehunt exhibited extraordinary devotion to duty, outstanding loyalty,  
11 fine leadership, and meticulous attention to detail in all his duties.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL  
13 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the portion of Ga. 60 Spur in Fannin County from Mineral  
14 Bluff to the North Carolina state line is dedicated as the Trooper Clyde Arthur Wehunt  
15 Memorial Highway.

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and  
17 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Trooper Clyde Arthur Wehunt  
18 Memorial Highway.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
20 and directed to transmit appropriate copies of this resolution to the family of Trooper Clyde  
21 Arthur Wehunt and to the Department of Transportation.
