- 1 Commending the Third Infantry Division of the United States Army at Fort Stewart-Hunter
- 2 Army Airfield and recognizing March 9, 2017, as Third Infantry Division Day at the state
- 3 capitol; and for other purposes.
- 4 WHEREAS, Fort Stewart is the largest United States Army military installation east of the
- 5 Mississippi River, situated on 284,924 acres with 617 miles of paved roads, 326 miles of dirt
- 6 roads, 538 miles of tank trails, and enough space to train two brigades simultaneously; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Fort Stewart has an annual economic impact of \$5.6 billion, affecting numerous
- 8 counties across the State of Georgia; and
- 9 WHEREAS, more than 2,000 civilians are employed at Fort Stewart, and more than 20,000
- 10 active duty military soldiers are stationed there; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Fort Stewart has been named the top United States Army installation in the
- 12 world six times, and soldiers from Fort Stewart have been deployed to Iraq and Afghanistan
- 13 on six different occasions in the past ten years; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Fort Stewart is home to the Third Infantry Division of the United States Army,
- 15 which has one of the most successful combat records of any United States Army division; and
- 16 WHEREAS, fifty-one members of the Third Infantry Division have been awarded the
- 17 Congressional Medal of Honor while serving the United States and its citizens; and
- 18 WHEREAS, the Third Infantry Division was deployed in World War I, World War II, the
- 19 Korean War, the Persian Gulf War, and Operation Iraqi Freedom, and it played an
- 20 instrumental role during the Cold War; and
