A RESOLUTION

1 Dedicating the Traditions Highway; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, several local governments and interested parties along Highway 15 have come
3 together to form the Highway 15 Coalition in order to promote economic development and
4 tourism along this important corridor; and

5 WHEREAS, Highway 15 traverses the state from the Tennessee state line to the Florida state
6 line and is a traditional route for travelers to the Georgia coast, the Classic City of Athens,
7 and on to the northeast Georgia mountains; and

8 WHEREAS, the Highway 15 corridor contains numerous features and stops promoted by
9 both the Georgia Department of Tourism and the Highway 15 Coalition that may be enjoyed
10 by travelers; and

11 WHEREAS, it abundantly fitting and proper that the Highway 15 corridor be dedicated as
12 the Traditions Highway.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
14 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the portion of Highway 15 from the Hancock County line
15 to the Appling County line through Washington, Johnson, Treutlen, Montgomery, and
16 Toombs counties is dedicated as the Traditions Highway.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
18 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Traditions Highway.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
20 and directed to make an appropriate copy of this resolution available for distribution to the
21 Department of Transportation.
