A RESOLUTION

- 1 Celebrating the Legislative Clergy Council event at the state capitol; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the Legislative Clergy Council event will be held at the Georgia State Capitol
3 on Monday, January 23, 2017; and
- 4 WHEREAS, this event is intended to corporately solicit God's wisdom, guidance, and
5 instruction as they pray and seek His counsel at the beginning of the 2017 legislative session;

- 7 WHEREAS, members of the Legislative Clergy Council pray, support, and advise the
8 members of the House of Representatives on how public policy impacts the religious
9 community in the great State of Georgia; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the Legislative Clergy Council expresses unity that bridges racial, ethnic, and
11 denominational divides by including male and female, black and white, Lutheran, Catholic,
12 Baptist, Presbyterian, Full Gospel, Anglican, Episcopalian, nondenominational, and
13 multidenominational and inviting all to join together; and
- 14 WHEREAS, clergy and faith members work together in unity with the State of Georgia in
15 sharing, networking, and innovating conversations that help serve the state and its
16 communities.
- 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
18 the members of this body celebrate the Legislative Clergy Council event at the state capitol.

20 and directed to make an appropriate copy of this resolution available for distribution to the
21 Legislative Clergy Council.
