## A RESOLUTION

Recognizing November 14, 2021, as African Methodist Episcopal Church 6th District
 Alzheimer's Awareness Purple Sunday; and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, Alzheimer's disease, a progressive neurodegenerative brain disorder, tragically
robs individuals of their memories and leads to progressive mental and physical impairments;

6 WHEREAS, there are no known treatments to prevent, cure, delay the onset, or slow the7 progression of Alzheimer's disease; and

8 WHEREAS, an estimated 5.6 million people aged 65 and over have Alzheimer's disease and

- 9 another 200,000 people under age 65 have younger-onset Alzheimer's disease; and
- WHEREAS, Alzheimer's disease is the sixth leading cause of death in the United States andthe fifth leading cause among the elderly; and

WHEREAS, African Americans are about two times more likely to have Alzheimer's diseaseand other dementias; and

WHEREAS, according to the Alzheimer's Association's Facts and Figures report, the direct costs of caring for those with Alzheimer's to American society is valued at \$355 billion, and more than 11 million care givers provide 15.3 billion hours of unpaid care to those with Alzheimer's disease or other dementias; and

WHEREAS, in Georgia, nearly 334,000 family members and friends cared for people with
Alzheimer's disease and other dementias, providing 640 million hours of unpaid care; the
annual value of this care giving totaled \$9.1 billion; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of the individuals, families, friends and care givers dealing with
Alzheimer's disease, there are researchers who are seeking a cause or cure; and

WHEREAS, the State of Georgia recognizes the efforts of the Alzheimer's Association to raise funds and promote awareness of the fight against Alzheimer's disease and other dementias, thereby improving the quality of human life for those living with Alzheimer's disease and their care givers; and

WHEREAS, November 14, 2021, has been recognized as African Methodist Episcopal
Church 6th District Alzheimer's Awareness Purple Sunday to help spread global awareness
of the Alzheimer's Association's vision of a world without Alzheimer's disease; and

WHEREAS, November 14, 2021, has been recognized by Bishop Reginald T. Jackson,
presiding prelate of the AME Sixth Episcopal District, as African Methodist Episcopal
Church 6th Episcopal District Alzheimer's Awareness Purple Sunday to help spread global
awareness of the Alzheimer's Association's vision of a world without Alzheimer's disease.

34 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that 35 the members of this body recognize November 14, 2021, as African Methodist Episcopal 36 Church 6th District Alzheimer's Awareness Purple Sunday and urge all citizens to show their 37 support on that day by wearing purple and engaging in a day of activity, honoring the 38 strength, passion, and endurance of people facing Alzheimer's disease.
