- 12 WHEREAS, Trail Life USA's robust awards program culminates with the esteemed Freedom
- 13 Award, which is already gaining recognition with Christian colleges and universities as a
- 14 symbol of high character, leadership experience, and skills; and
- 15 WHEREAS, there are more than 26,000 trailmen and 680 troops in the United States,
- including 2,176 trailmen and 34 troops, with eight troops in Georgia and 93 nationally in the
- 17 process of chartering; and
- 18 WHEREAS, on June 25, 2015, American Heritage Girls and Trail Life USA signed a
- 19 Memorandum of Ministry Alliance, the highest form of relationship for each organization,
- and it was approved by both boards; and
- 21 WHEREAS, American Heritage Girls have 45,309 national members in all 50 states, 1,017
- troops nationally, 1,820 members in Georgia, and 38 troops in the State of Georgia; and
