A RESOLUTION

- 1 Creating the House Study Committee on Public Utility Payment Options for Customers in
- 2 Need of Assistance; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, public utility companies that provide necessities, such as electricity, gas, water,
- 4 and telephone service, have customers who from time to time are unable to pay their utility
- 5 bills in a timely manner; and
- 6 WHEREAS, many of these customers are receiving temporary assistance for needy families
- 7 (TANF), aid to the aged, blind, and disabled (AABD), benefits from general assistance or
- 8 supplemental security income, income from social security benefits or veterans benefits, or
- 9 unemployment compensation benefits; and
- 10 WHEREAS, a committee to investigate the best way to assist such customers is needed; and
- WHEREAS, options, such as a budget payment plan with a preferred payment date, should
- 12 be considered; and
- 13 WHEREAS, it would be beneficial to both the customers and the public utilities to study the
- 14 feasibility of a program that would provide an alternative payment plan that would provide
- much needed relief to customers receiving certain benefits, while ensuring that the moneys
- 16 owed to the public utility companies are ultimately paid.
- 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:
- 18 (1) **Creation of House study committee.** There is created the House Study Committee
- on Public Utility Payment Options for Customers in Need of Assistance.
- 20 (2) **Members and officers.** The committee shall be composed of five members of the
- 21 House of Representatives to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of
- Representatives. The Speaker shall designate a member of the committee as chairperson
- of the committee.

24 (3) **Powers and duties.** The committee shall undertake a study of the conditions, needs,

- 25 issues, and problems mentioned above or related thereto and recommend any action or
- legislation which the committee deems necessary or appropriate.
- 27 (4) **Meetings.** The chairperson shall call all meetings of the committee. The committee
- 28 may conduct such meetings at such places and at such times as it may deem necessary or
- convenient to enable it to exercise fully and effectively its powers, perform its duties, and
- accomplish the objectives and purposes of this resolution.
- 31 (5) **Allowances and funding.** The legislative members of the committee shall receive
- 32 the allowances provided for in Code Section 28-1-8 of the Official Code of Georgia
- Annotated. The allowances authorized by this resolution shall not be received by any
- member of the committee for more than five days unless additional days are authorized.
- Funds necessary to carry out the provisions of this resolution shall come from funds
- appropriated to the House of Representatives.
- 37 (6) **Report.**
- 38 (A) In the event the committee adopts any specific findings or recommendations that
- include suggestions for proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file a report of the
- same prior to the date of abolishment specified in this resolution, subject to
- subparagraph (C) of this paragraph.
- 42 (B) In the event the committee adopts a report that does not include suggestions for
- proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file the report, subject to subparagraph (C)
- of this paragraph.
- 45 (C) No report shall be filed unless the same has been approved prior to the date of
- abolishment specified in this resolution by majority vote of a quorum of the committee.
- 47 A report so approved shall be signed by the chairperson of the committee and filed with
- 48 the Clerk of the House of Representatives.
- (D) In the absence of an approved report, the chairperson may file with the Clerk of the
- House of Representatives a copy of the minutes of the meetings of the committee in lieu
- 51 thereof.
- 52 (7) **Abolishment.** The committee shall stand abolished on December 1, 2017.
