- 13 as President of the Wayne County Chamber of Commerce and Vice Chair of the State Board
- 14 of Corrections, and he held memberships with the Lions Club, Kiwanis Club, and the
- 15 Masons; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Stetson was the founding member of the Jesup Jaycees and the Wayne
- 17 Memorial Hospital Board; and
- 18 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern
- 19 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his
- 20 family and friends were admired by others; and
