A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Commissioner C. Brooks Bailey on the occasion of his
2 retirement; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Commissioner C. Brooks Bailey has long been recognized by the citizens of
4 this state for the vital role that he has played in leadership and his deep personal commitment
5 to the welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, he has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of his time,
7 talents, and energy toward public service as evidenced dramatically by the multiple
8 leadership positions he has assumed throughout his career in order to support the state; and

9 WHEREAS, Commissioner Bailey was born and raised in Johnson County, Georgia,
10 graduated from Wrightsville High School in 1953, and has lived in Pulaski County since
11 1972; and

12 WHEREAS, he dutifully served two years in the U.S. Army Signal Corps as a cryptographer
13 followed by 36 years as a valued employee at Georgia Power, retiring as the area manager
14 for Perry, Hawkinsville, and Cochran, Georgia; and

15 WHEREAS, Commissioner Bailey has actively exercised his leadership skills for the
16 development of Pulaski County as president of the Rotary Club, the Chamber of Commerce,
17 the Booster Club, and United Pulaski Development and the benefit of others through his
18 former role as a member of the board of directors for SunMark Community Bank; and

19 WHEREAS, he was elected as Pulaski County's sole commissioner in 2000 and completed
20 the County Commissioners' Certification Program in 2002 and Advanced Certification from
21 the Leadership Academy in 2003; and

22 WHEREAS, Commissioner Bailey has been an active member of the Association County
23 Commissioners of Georgia and the Middle Georgia Regional Development Center; and

24 WHEREAS, a man of deep and abiding faith, Commissioner Bailey currently serves as
25 chairman of deacons, finance chairman, and Sunday school teacher at Broad Street Baptist
26 Church; and

27 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
28 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
30 the members of this body commend Commissioner C. Brooks Bailey for his dedicated public
31 service to the State of Georgia, congratulate him upon the grand occasion of his retirement,
