A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Jordan Holley for winning the gold medal at the state competition as the best
2 overall male weight lifter, and setting world records in the deadlift and squat at the 2019
3 Revolution Powerlifting Sarasota Showdown; and for other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, on January 26, 2019, Pike County High School junior Jordan Holley set world
5 records in the deadlift and squat in his age division at the 2019 Revolution Powerlifting
6 Sarasota Showdown in Sarasota, Florida; and

7 WHEREAS, Jordan was in the 220 pound, Teen 16 to 17, Raw Classic division at the
8 January 26, 2019 meet and broke two world records, including one that had stood for ten
9 years; and

10 WHEREAS, Jordan's deadlift was 578 pounds and his squat was 531 pounds, breaking a
11 world record that had been held since 2009. Jordan weighed in at 214 pounds at the meet
12 and was 16 years old; and

13 WHEREAS, on March 9, 2019, Jordan Holley won the gold medal at the state competition
14 and holds the squat state record in the 105k weight class, the deadlift state record, and the
15 total state record and was rewarded the overall best male weight lifter out of 64 competitors;
16 and

17 WHEREAS, Jordan is the son of Trey and Sasha Holley and is trained by Scott Ryals of Iron
18 Works Gym in Thomaston, Georgia.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
20 the members of this body commend Jordan Holley for his weightlifting records and gold
21 medal at the state competition and extend their best wishes for Jordan's success at the
22 National Championship Competition in Louisiana on March 29 through April 1, 2019.
