- 2 WHEREAS, Lieutenant General Lee K. Levy II has diligently and selflessly served this
3 country through his service with the United States Air Force; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Lieutenant General Levy was born in New Orleans, Louisiana, and entered the
5 Air Force in 1985 as a Louisiana State University ROTC graduate; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he has since tirelessly continued his education, including Squadron Officer
7 School, Maxwell AFB, in 1988; Master of Arts degree in national security and strategic
8 studies from the Naval War College in 2004; Joint and Combined Warfare School from the
9 Joint Forces Staff College in 2007; and Senior Executives in National and International
10 Security Program at the John F. Kennedy School of Government at Harvard University in
11 2012; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Lieutenant General Levy has been awarded with the Distinguished Service
13 Medal, Defense Superior Service Medal, Legion of Merit, Defense Meritorious Service
14 Medal with oak leaf cluster, Meritorious Service Medal with four oak leaf clusters, Air Force
15 Commendation Medal with oak leaf cluster, Joint Service Achievement Medal, Air Force
16 Achievement Medal, and Nuclear Deterrence Operations Service Medal with oak leaf cluster;

- 18 WHEREAS, our nation's security continues to rely on the brave and dedicated military
19 heroes who stand ever ready to lay the ultimate sacrifice upon the altar of freedom; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Commander of the Air Force Sustainment Center, Air Force Materiel
21 Command, Tinker Air Force Base, Oklahoma, he ensures the Center provides operational
22 planning and execution for the Air Force supply chain management and depot maintenance
