- 24 Markets serving as chairwoman; Mary Stacy serving as chairwoman of the Supplier
- 25 Committee; Haley Bower of Clipper Petroleum serving as the Legislative Committee
- 26 chairwoman; and Angela Holland, CAE, serving as the president.
