A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing November 20, 2021, as Trans Day of Remembrance; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Trans Day of Remembrance is an annual observance held on November 20 that
- 3 honors the memory of the transgender people whose lives were lost in acts of
- 4 anti-transgender violence; and
- 5 WHEREAS, it is important that we reflect on the transgender community, acknowledge the
- 6 abuse that they face on a regular basis, and honor victims of anti-transgender violence with
- 7 the respect and dignity that they deserve; and
- 8 WHEREAS, we must understand the implications of this continuous violence against the
- 9 transgender community; the occurrence of anti-transgender violence reinforces the fear that
- alienates the transgender community and pushes them away from community services and
- 11 support; and
- 12 WHEREAS, within the State of Georgia, we have lost Serenity Hollis, a 24-year-old Black
- 13 transgender woman; Sophie Vásquez, a 36-year-old Latina transgender woman; and Bianca
- 14 "Muffin" Bankz, a Black transgender woman in her early 30s; and

- 15 WHEREAS, on Trans Day of Remembrance, we honor and uplift the following:
- The fallen transgender and gender non-conforming individuals whose lives were taken
- 17 from them prematurely; and
- Those who lack family and social support; and
- 19 Those who experience quality of life issues, such as chronic homelessness, substance
- abuse, and mental illness; and
- Those who experience intimate partner violence; and
- Those who lack access to appropriate and affirming medical care and social services.
- 23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 24 the members of this body recognize November 20, 2021, as Trans Day of Remembrance and
- 25 honor the victims of anti-transgender violence.
- 26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- 27 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
- 28 public and the press.
