13 was known for his outstanding work with Georgia Power Company, Southern Company
14 Services, KPMG, and his partner firm, Nichols, Cauley & Associates, LLC; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Farrell passionately served as a member of many prestigious accounting
16 organizations such as the Georgia State Board of Accountancy, the American Institute of
17 Certified Public Accountants, and the Institute of Internal Auditors; and
- 18 WHEREAS, he will always be remembered by family, friends, and colleagues for his
19 pleasantness, generosity, and love for the Georgia Bulldogs; and
