A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Police Chief James Conroy on his outstanding public service;
2 and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Police Chief James Conroy has long been recognized as one of the foremost
4 public servants in the State of Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, prior to joining the police, Chief James Conroy grew up in DeKalb County
6 attending Peachtree High School; and

7 WHEREAS, he attended the University of Georgia and received a Bachelor's degree in
8 Criminal Justice Administration from Columbia Southern University; and

9 WHEREAS, he is a graduate of the Southern Police Institute at the University of Louisville,
10 the Police Executive Research Forum's Senior Management Institute for Police in Boston,
11 Massachusetts, Leadership DeKalb Class of 2015, and is currently pursuing a Master's
12 degree at Waldorf University; and

13 WHEREAS, in his 26 year tenure at the DeKalb County Police Department, Chief Conroy
14 has undertaken a variety of assignments, including assignments in the uniform division,
15 North Precinct, Tucker Precinct, homicide unit, and sex crimes unit in the criminal
16 investigations division; and

17 WHEREAS, Chief Conroy has served as commander of several areas, including the North
18 Precinct youth and sex crimes section, crime analysis and research section, information
19 services division, E911 Director, chief of staff, and as the assistant chief over the support
20 services division; and

21 WHEREAS, since December 2013, Chief James Conroy has served as police chief of
22 DeKalb County; and

23 WHEREAS, Chief Conroy is also active outside the police department, serving on the
24 executive boards of several organizations such as the Gold Shield Foundation of Metro
25 Atlanta, the Metro Atlanta Police Emerald Society, and DeKalb County Police Athletic
26 League Plus Inc.; and

27 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
28 extraordinary chief of police be appropriately recognized.

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
30 the members of this body congratulate Police Chief James Conroy on the grand occasion of
31 his retirement, commend his innumerable contributions to public safety, and extend sincere
32 best wishes for continued health and happiness.
