## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Pamela Franklin Stegall; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Pamela Franklin Stegall, affectionately called "Miss P.", is a native of Atlanta;  
3 she attended English Avenue Elementary School from kindergarten through the seventh  
4 grade, the Salvation Army's Bellwood Boys and Girls Club, and she graduated from Booker  
5 T. Washington High School; and

6 WHEREAS, she returned to college in 2000 to pursue her undergraduate degree after being  
7 out of school for more than 25 years; in 2010, she graduated Cum Laude from Spelman  
8 College in Atlanta, Georgia, with a bachelor of arts degree in theatre, and she was inducted  
9 as a member of the Phi Beta Kappa National Honor Society; and

10 WHEREAS, in 2014, Pamela received her master of arts degree in arts administration from  
11 Savannah College of Art and Design; and

12 WHEREAS, Pamela worked as a stage manager for the 2000-2006 production tour of *The*  
13 *Journey* written by Gabrielle Johnson of Gabin Entertainment; she also has backstage  
14 management experience from the following productions: *The Colored Museum*, the world  
15 premier of *A Song for Coretta*, *Black Nativity*, *Speak Easy* 2009 and 2010, *Dream of My Life*,  
16 *Amen Corner*, *The Odd Couple*, Representative Joseph Lowery's 85th, 90th, and 92nd  
17 birthday celebrations, and *The Bluest Eye*; and

18 WHEREAS, in 2010, she added filmmaker to her list of accomplishments with her  
19 production of the documentary *Fly, Sista, Fly* and most recently, *4 Little Girls*; and

20 WHEREAS, Pamela believes that each of us must give something back to our communities;  
21 she is a member of the DREAM Team of G.V.C.O.P., Inc., and serves as Executive Director  
22 of the Pamela D. Franklin Cultural Center for the Performing Arts; and

23 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this  
24 remarkable and distinguished woman be appropriately recognized.
