A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Georgia's working women for their contributions toward
- 2 building strong families and supporting Georgia's economy; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Georgia strives to remain the No. 1 state to do business in; and

4 WHEREAS, economic security is a critically important concern for women as well as for

their children and partners and is crucial for the health and viability of Georgia communitiesand economy; and

7 WHEREAS, women make up 65 percent of the low wage workforce in the state, many of8 whom are considered essential workers; and

9 WHEREAS, women compose more than half of Georgia's adult population and are the 10 primary or co-breadwinners in more than half of all Georgia's households with children; and

WHEREAS, there are a multitude of factors that may contribute to earnings differences
between women and men, including age, number of hours worked, pregnancy or the presence
of children, level of education, and the type of jobs worked; and

WHEREAS, research has shown that policy solutions such as salary transparency, increased paid sick days and paid leave, accessible and affordable childcare, stable housing, and workplace protections are all known to have a positive impact on women and families and would boost Georgia's economy as much as \$14.4 billion; and

WHEREAS, protections for pregnant women at work ensure that women remain an integral
part of the workforce and have healthy pregnancies and deliveries, strengthening Georgia's
families overall; and

WHEREAS, sixty percent of all working Georgians cannot access the unpaid Family
Medical Leave Act due to ineligibility or being unable to afford to take leave without pay;
implementing policies such as paid leave would increase women's labor force participation
rate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
the members of this body support legislation that would provide needed economic support
and security for women, their families, and Georgia's economy.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
public and the press.
