1 Celebrating the 60th anniversary of the Alpharetta Elementary School building; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Alpharetta Elementary School was established to serve the rural Alpharetta
4 community beginning with the 1956-1957 school year; and

5 WHEREAS, it has continued to serve the growing Alpharetta community as part of the
6 Fulton County School system, Northwest Learning Community for 60 school years; and

7 WHEREAS, under the helm of Principal Coretta Stewart, the school prides itself on cultural
8 diversity, with over 14 languages represented, as well as the largest special needs population
9 in the area; and

10 WHEREAS, as the oldest school in North Fulton, Alpharetta Elementary School students
11 continue to achieve academic excellence and success; and

12 WHEREAS, for the residents of the Alpharetta area, the elementary school is not simply a
13 place of learning; the building is a symbol of their intimate kinship with the past as well as
14 their greatest hope for the future of their children.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
16 the members of this body join in celebrating the 60th anniversary of the Alpharetta
17 Elementary School building; express gratitude to the teachers, administrators, and staff for
18 their excellent service in guiding each new generation of young Georgians; and extend their
19 sincerest best wishes for the school's future growth and success.
