- 17 extraordinary devotion to duty, outstanding loyalty, fine leadership, and meticulous attention
- 18 to detail in all of his duties; and
- 19 WHEREAS, his commitment to the welfare of others is an outstanding example of the
- 20 positive effect law enforcement professionals have on the lives and well-being of others; and
