- 2 WHEREAS, former vice president of AT&T, Dr. John H. Carter managed a successful
3 consulting firm, Carter & Carter LLC; served as an adjunct professor at Strayer University;
4 and worked as a course developer and seminar presenter for the Nonprofit University until
5 fully retiring in 2016; and
- 6 WHEREAS, a native of Thomaston, Georgia, he has served on various boards over the years
7 to include the American Red Cross, American Lung Association, Georgia Business
8 Roundtable, National Minority Purchasing Council, and many others; and
- 9 WHEREAS, he in an active member of his church, Cascade United Methodist, where he has
10 served as a chairperson of the higher education committee; and
- 11 WHEREAS, he has been recognized with numerous awards from the community, such as the
12 Morris Brown College Alumnus of the Year; 1992 Alpha Phi Alpha state, regional, and
13 national Brother of the Year; Who's Who in America; Alpha Phi Alpha Presidential Award
14 of Merit; BellSouth Services' Presidential Award of Excellence; and more; and

15 WHEREAS, a world traveler, Dr. Carter has climbed the Great Wall of China; visited the
16 Sphinx and Pyramids of Egypt; stood at the throne of Peter the Great in Russia and the
17 former jail cell of Nelson Mandela; toured the castles of Europe, Switzerland, Germany, Italy
18 and Australia; sailed the rivers of the Rhine and Nile; navigated the Caribbean, South China,
19 Baltic, Tasman, Red and Mediterranean seas; and cruised the Atlantic, Indian, Southern, and
20 Pacific Oceans; and

21 WHEREAS, John recently authored a book titled *Hold My Mule*, wherein he wrote about
22 growing up in a segregated south and rising through corporate America as a young Black
23 man; and

24 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
25 extraordinary individual be appropriately commended and recognized.
