## A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life of SPC Adam L. Harrell and dedicating an intersection in his memory; and  
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, our nation's security continues to rely on patriotic men and women who put  
4 their personal lives on hold in order to place themselves in harm's way to protect the  
5 freedoms that all United States citizens cherish; and

6 WHEREAS, SPC Adam L. Harrell served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty  
7 with the United States Army's 82nd Airborne Division; and

8 WHEREAS, SPC Harrell demonstrated a deep personal commitment to protecting  
9 democracy and a willingness to sacrifice his own personal safety and comfort to ensure the  
10 well-being of his fellow man during Operation Inherent Resolve; and

11 WHEREAS, his skill was recognized with an expert marksmanship badge, and he earned a  
12 reputation from his commanders and peers as a soldier who was willing to mentor and  
13 support others; and

14 WHEREAS, SPC Harrell embodied the spirit of service, willing to find meaning in  
15 something greater than himself, and it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable  
16 and distinguished Georgian be recognized appropriately by dedicating an intersection in his  
17 memory.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL  
19 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the intersection of State Route 8 and State Route  
20 378/Beaver Ruin Road in Gwinnett County is dedicated as the SPC Adam L. Harrell  
21 Memorial Intersection.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and  
23 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the SPC Adam L. Harrell  
24 Memorial Intersection.

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
26 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the  
27 family of SPC Adam L. Harrell and to the Department of Transportation.
