- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens
3 with the passing of David Jones on February 3, 2022; and
- 4 WHEREAS, David Jones was born on December 10, 1932, in Savannah, Georgia, a beloved
5 son of Lucius and IV Jones; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty with the United
7 States Air Force, valiantly and courageously protecting his fellow Americans for four years
8 as air police; and
- 9 WHEREAS, after a distinguished 31 year career with the Savannah Police Department,
10 David Jones served for 12 years as the First District Alderman to the people of Savannah;

- 12 WHEREAS, he was united in love and marriage to his wife, MaryAnn, and was blessed with
13 three remarkable daughters; and

14 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern
15 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his
16 family and friends were admired by others; and

17 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
18 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example he made of his life, he
19 made this world a better place in which to live; and

20 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, David Jones will long be remembered for
21 his love of family, friendship, and community and will be missed by all who had the great
22 fortune of knowing him.

24 the members of this body join in honoring the life and memory of David Jones and express
25 their deepest and most sincere regret at his passing.
