A RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution so as to change the date by which temporary loans for counties, municipalities, and other political subdivisions of this state are payable in full from the end of the calendar year to within 12 months of the initial funding date of the loans; to provide for related matters; to provide for the submission of this amendment for ratification or rejection; and for other purposes.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

8 Article IX, Section V of the Constitution is amended by revising Paragraph V as follows: 9 "Paragraph V. *Temporary loans authorized*. The governing authority of any county, 10 municipality, or other political subdivision of this state may incur debt by obtaining 11 temporary loans in each year to pay expenses. The aggregate amount of all such loans shall 12 not exceed 75 percent of the total gross income from taxes collected in the last preceding 13 year. Such loans shall be payable on or before December 31 of the calendar year in which 14 such loan is made in full within 12 months of the initial funding date of the loan. No such 15 loan may be obtained when there is a loan then unpaid obtained in any prior year an 16 existing loan authorized pursuant to this Paragraph for such county, municipality, or other 17 political subdivision of this state which has not been paid in full within 12 months of the tial founding data of mus

18 <u>initial funding date of such existing loan</u>. No such county, municipality, or other political 19 subdivision of this state shall incur in any one calendar year <u>at any time</u> an aggregate of 20 such temporary loans or other contracts, notes, warrants, or obligations for current expenses 21 in excess of the total anticipated revenue for such calendar year <u>over the immediately</u> 22 following 12 months."

SECTION 2.

The above proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be published and submitted as provided in Article X, Section I, Paragraph II of the Constitution. The ballot submitting the above proposed amendment shall have written or printed thereon the following:

- 31 All persons desiring to vote in favor of ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "Yes."

32 All persons desiring to vote against ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "No." If

33 such amendment shall be ratified as provided in said Paragraph of the Constitution, it shall

34 become a part of the Constitution of this state.
