- became a well-respected lawyer and partner at Wilson, Brock and Irby for over 25 years; and

- 22 in East Point, Georgia; and
- 23 WHEREAS, he was united in love and marriage to his wife, Katherine, and was blessed with
- 24 four remarkable children, Rodrick, Joseph, Joice, and Tiffany; seven wonderful
- 25 grandchildren, Dillon, Evan, Maceo, Nigel, Mallory, Aleks, Eden, and Cameron; and three
- spectacular great-grandchildren, Faithlynn, Raven, and Iefan; and
